



A token economy system will be implemented using STARR Buck. All adults will issue STARR currency to reinforce students for their appropriate behaviour. During the fall training activities and for a period of time after the first days of school, faculty/staff should generously distribute tickets to students so they will have plenty of opportunities to learn early on that following the STARR expectations will result in something positive. The tokens clearly communicate that, when students follow the STARR expectations, their behaviour will be positively acknowledged. It gets the students' attention and "hooks" them to the token economy system early in the school year.

### **STARR BUCK:**

The overall goal is to find ways to reward students with STARR Buck on a daily basis. All teachers will have STARR Buck to give to students, and all students have an opportunity to earn it.

### **General Guidelines:**

- STARR Buck will be printed on one color paper only
- A Master copy will be used on an "as needed" basis
- Opportunities to exchange STARR Buck for privileges/rewards will be available on a weekly and monthly basis.
- STARR Buck should NEVER be taken away from students once it has been earned. It is best to be selective about how and when they earn them rather than to take it away as punishment.
- Students may not buy, sell, or give away coupons to other students.

### **Procedures:**

- STARR Buck may be given anywhere a student is caught following the school-wide expectations.
- Students will collect/save STARR Buck as they will be able to exchange them for some type of reward during the initial training and the weeks that follow.
- When a substitute is in the classroom, students receive a different color of buck, which are worth double the value of the STARR Buck.

**STARR Buck Storing and Collection Ideas:** (Management procedures may vary depending upon grade levels.)

- Write first and last names on the back of STARR Buck to prevent them from being stolen or lost.
- Infant Department (Reception-Years 3): Establish a central location in the classroom to house STARR Buck such as a class bank, pocket charts, Ziploc bags, ...
- Junior Department (Years 4-6): Could use the above-mentioned procedures or they could teach the students to be responsible for their own STARR Buck. If bucks are lost, they will not be replaced.
- The total number of STARR buck(s) received by each student each week need to be recorded and emailed to the PBIS leader.

**STARR Buck redemption:**

These are opportunities for students to spend their STARR Buck for activities. These activities typically occur on Fridays. By Thursday afternoon, teachers should assist students with counting.
