

# WEST END PRIMARY SCHOOL

## UNIFORM POLICY

**UNIFORM** All students must wear **white polo shirt with the school crest on the left breast** and worn with **navy blue long pants, shorts or skorts** (available from Ocean Breeze Tailoring or Stylish Variety).

- All shorts and skorts must be knee length and not above the knee.
- Shirts/tops are to be tucked into trousers so the waistband is clearly showing at all times.
- Pants must be worn on the waist and not too loose, if the pants have belt loops a black or brown belt must be worn at all times. Pants of denim material or in a jeans style are not acceptable.
- Plain white undershirts may be worn but all undergarments should not be visible.

**Our school Crest is a part of the school uniform** and should be worn by ALL STUDENTS. It is available from the school for \$3.00 each.

**SHOES** **Black containing no other colours.** Shoes with lights, wheels (Heeley's), sandals, flip flops, or boots are not permitted at West End Primary School.

- Shoes are to be worn with **white, navy blue or black socks**. Socks should be by the ankle or above. (No low cut socks below ankle. Socks must be seen).

**SWEATERS** If a student wishes to wear a sweater it is to be a proper-fitting **navy** sweater/jacket with **no hood**.

**HOUSE KIT** **Black athletic, long pants, shorts or skorts that are knee length and yellow Hornets or red Charger shirt** (also available from the Ocean Breeze Tailoring) are to be worn on PE/Swimming & Sports Days.

**HAIR** Girls' hair should be groomed and, if worn long, be tied back with a hair band (hair band should match the uniform colours) for health and safety reasons.

Boys' hair should be cut short. Hair is required to be a natural colour, and extremes of hairstyles, such as a Mohawk, shaved lines/words, are not permitted. No beads should be worn in the hair.

Make up, nail polish, and false fingernails may not be worn.

**JEWELLERY** Except for a watch, no other jewellery should be worn.
